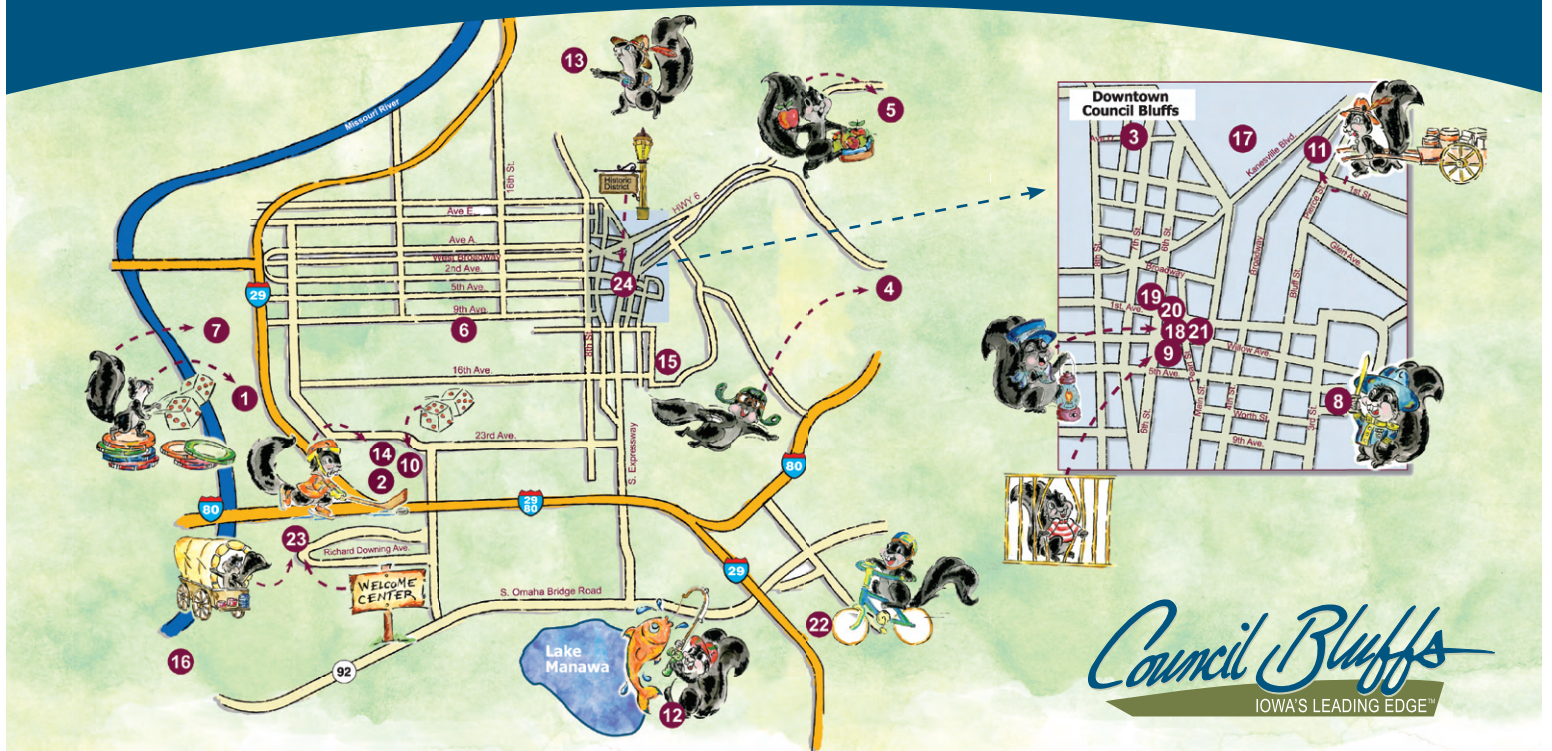

The spot where East meets West!



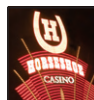
**7. Harrah's C.B. Casino & Hotel**
